## CITATION

Shri Sam Pitroda is an internationally respected development thinker, policy maker, telecom inventor and entrepreneur who has spent over four decades in Information and Communications Technology and related human and national developments initiatives. Credited with having laid the foundation of India's technology and telecommunications revolution in the 1980s, Shri Pitroda has been a leading campaigner to help bridge the global digital divide. During his tenure as Adviser to Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi in the 1980s Shri Pitroda headed six technology missions related to telecommunications, water, literacy, immunization, dairy and oil seeds. He was also the founder and first chairman of India's Telecom Commission. In these roles, he helped revolutionise India's development policies and philosophies with a focus on access to technology as the key to social change. Shri Pitroda was Chairman of India's National Knowledge Commission (2005-2009), an advisory body to the Prime Minister of India, set up to provide a blueprint for reform of the knowledge related institutions and infrastructure in the country. The Commission has offered a series of recommendations on various aspects of the knowledge paradigm to help India meet the challenges of the 21st century. He is currently Adviser to the Prime Minister of India on Public Information Infrastructure and Innovations. In his new role he has undertaken the ambitious task of providing a plan for creating digital infrastructure in the country for enhancing governance, democratising information and improving delivery of public services with a focus on providing broadband connectivity to rural areas. He is also the Chairman of the National Innovation Council (NInC) which is working on several initiatives to boost innovation performance in the country. Shri Pitroda is also heading the Expert Committee on the use of ICT in Railways and is the Chairman of the Smart Grid Task Force set up under the aegis of the Ministry of Power, Government of India. He has also been appointed as one of the founding Commissioners of the United Nations Broadband Commission for Digital Development. He holds close to 100 worldwide patents and has published and lectured widely in the US, Europe, Latin America and Asia. He is also the recipient of numerous awards including the World Telecommunication and Information Society Award by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) in 2011 and the Padma Bhushan by the Government of India for his contribution in Science and Engineering.

For his outstanding services to the nation in the field of Telecommunications and in recognition of his contribution in promoting ICTs for expediting process of development and help bridging the global divide, the Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers confers upon Shri Sam Pitroda, the Honorary Fellowship of the Institution.


# Conferment of Honorary Fellowship of the IETE on Shri Sam Pitroda

## **IETE Honorary Fellows (2010-2011)**



Prof V N Rajasekharan Pillai, Vice-Chancellor of Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU), New Delhi, is the Honorary Fellow of the Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers, the professional apex body for Electronics & Telecommunication, CS & IT in India. He is also the Chairman of the Distance Education Council (DEC), which looks after the co-ordination of standards, quality, recognition and development assistance to all the 13 State Open Universities, over 150 Distance Education Institutes in the Conventional Universities and in other private Open and Distance Learning institutions in the Country. Prof Pillai has been at the helm of affairs of many higher education institutions during his career spanning about 4 decades. His experiences and contributions to the field of science and educational administration are rich and varied. He has served as the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the University

Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi; Director of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore; Vice-Chancellor of the Cochin University of Science and Technology; Founder-Director of the School of Chemical Sciences; Dean of Faculty of Science; Controller of Examinations; Director of College Development Council; Founder-Director of the School of Professional Distance Education and Chief, Employment and Information Guidance Bureau of the Mahatma Gandhi University. He is a Fellow of the prestigious Indian Academy of Sciences and an Honorary Senior Fellow of the Jawaharlal Nehru Centre for Advanced Scientific Research, Bangalore. An active teacher and researcher in the field of Chemical Sciences, Prof Rajasekharan Pillai has held post-doctoral and visiting research professor positions in the Universities of Tubingen (Germany), Mainz (Germany) and LAUSANNE (Switzerland). He created an internationally renowned research group in the area of biopolymers and peptides and has published extensively (about 200 refereed research publication in International journals) in this area. Over 50 doctoral researchers have been guided by him, all of them now occupying leading positions in academia, R&D, and industry in India and abroad. His research publications have received over 1600 citations during the last 18 years and he is among the top-cited chemists in the country. He holds an International patent for the gramscale preparation of biologically important peptides. In Jan 2008, he received the Presidential Gold Medal of the Indian Science Congress from the Prime Minister of India. In 2007, he has been conferred the Triennial National M V Pylee Award for the Top Academician of India in 2006, Prof Pillai was recognized by the R R Verma Foundation Best Teacher Award in 2005, he received the Indian Chemical Society Award for his life-long research achievements in the area of Chemical Sciences. In 1996 Dr Pillai received the Materials Research Society of India Lecture Award. His contributions to science and education have also been recognized by the conferment of honorary doctorates. Widely traveled all over the world, Dr Pillai has presented papers, given invited and plenary lectures, chaired sessions in a large number of National and International conferences, delivered Convocation Addresses, Endowment Lectures and Special Orations in a large number of Universities and Institutions. He has hosted several National and International discussions/meetings including Indian Academy of Sciences Annual Meeting and Vice-Chancellors Conferences.



Prof D P Agrawal, Chairman, Union Public Service Commission, New Delhi, is the Honorary Fellow of the Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers, the professional apex body for Electronics & Telecommunication, CS & IT in India. He has also worked as Member, UPSC, from Oct 2003 -Aug 2008. Before joining UPSC, Prof D P Agrawal was the founder Director of ABV Indian Institute of Information Technology and Management (ABV-IIITM), Gwalior, a Deemed University, set up by Ministry of HRD, Govt of India. Many initiatives started by him at IIITM, Gwalior, have been replicated in the country. Prof Agrawal, MTech & PhD from IIT, Delhi, has been an eminent teacher, educational administrator and institution builder. He was Professor and Dean at IIT- Delhi from where he took over as Joint Educational Adviser (T) in the Ministry of HRD, Govt of India, in 1994. While in the Ministry of HRD, he planned and developed a number of initiatives at national level in technical education, particularly in the areas of IT& Computer

education. He has made substantial contribution for the development of vocational education through advice and guidance. He was instrumental in conceptualizing a number of new institutions. Professor Agrawal was National Project Director of the World Bank assisted project for strengthening technical education in India. This project covered 19 states and 590 polytechnics. He has contributed to the development of Centres for Excellence in higher technical and polytechnic education. His initiatives as a Project Director for Indo-UK-REC's Project, lead to REC's become National Institute of Technology. Prof Agrawal was MD of Educational Consultants India Ltd. (Ed.CIL), a PSU of Govt of India. At IIT Delhi, Prof Agrawal held many key administrative positions including Dean of students. He was very active in academics and research too and supervised over 100 thesis at PhD, Masters and Undergraduate levels. He attracted research funds to IIT, Delhi, for his projects from Defence, DST and CSIR. In addition to being a member of a number of governing bodies of institutions, Prof Agrawal is a Fellow member of a number of professional institutions and societies in India and abroad. He has been Chairman of Central Regional Committee of AICTE and Chairman of many Boards of AICTE. He is known for his out of box thinking related to higher and technical education. He has been the recipients of many awards including 'Eminent Engineers' Award from Institution of Engineers. He has been awarded the Honorary Degree of Jiwaji University, Gwalior. He has been a visiting faculty at Imperial College, London, and Cranfield University in the UK. He has lectured in Germany and Czechoslovakia and led a number of delegations of the Govt of India to USA, Australia, Germany, New Zealand and Canada.


