IETE Celebrates 58th Foundation Day

The 58th Foundation Day was celebrated on 2nd Nov 2011 at IETE HQ with Dr Ashok K Chauhan, Founder President, Amity Education Group and Amity Universities, as the Chief Guest. The theme chosen for the Day was, "Environmental Technologies: The Future of India". Distinguished speakers on the occasion included : Dr Pradipto Ghosh, Distinguished Fellow, TERI; Shri Sharad Sadhu, Director, Technical, ABU; Dr Alok Adholeya, Director, Biotechnology and Bioresources Division, TERI and Shri M B Nirmal, Founder, Exnora International. Shri H O Agrawal, Vice President IETE in his welcome address said that green house gas emissions associated with huge energy consumption were challenging the environmental technologists to ensure economically viable and environmental friendly resources. For that the potentials of solar energy are to be realized, which are abundantly available in the country. He concluded acknowledging the Environmental Technology as the lead factor in the area of economic development and growth for the country.

Shri R K Gupta, President IETE, recounting the history of IETE, identified the future thrust areas for sustainable growth of the institution. He highlighted the vision of IETE with focus on Rural Development & Green Technologies, recalled the contributions made by former members of IETE which lead IETE to its present status. He also said that Dr Ashok K Chauhan had given a new direction to education in the private sector in the northern region. He said that the green technologies would be the future, minimizing deterioration of natural environmental resources. He assured that IETE too would take the cause to greater heights through the use of affordable technologies.

Among the Distinguished Speakers, Shri M B Nirmal spoke on 'Global Dangers' of environmental pollution and the ill effects of global warming, melting of polar caps, loss of farm lands due to population explosion and also suggested some methods to counter

these ill-effects. Dr Alok Adholeya spoke on the developmental activities on environmental technologies in India and covered the presentation on Ganga cleaning, tannery waste, fly ash, distiller effluents, etc. He highlighted the efforts being taken up by TERI to tackle the environmental problems. Dr Pradipto Ghosh gave detailed presentation on cellulosic biomass, power generation technologies based on biomass, R&D challenges of biomass, solar based power generation technologies and hybridization of solar power. Shri Sharad Sadhu's presentation was focused on 'Green Broadcasting' in which he highlighted the various green steps advocated by his organization. He said although the use of green technology was costly affair but with less operational cost, it would help to reduce the carbon footprints.

The senior members of IETE felicitated by the HQs on this occasion were : Brig R C Dhingra, Maj Gen K B Narang (Retd), Shri V P Sethi, Shri R N Goyal, Brig R N Bhatia and Lt Col M Guha. The Chief Guest Dr A K Chauhan, released the latest issue of IETE Newsletter on this occasion.

Dr Ashok K Chauhan, in his address, applauded the role played by Institutions like IETE in spreading higher technical education. Realizing the importance of environmental technology, he expressed his desire to jointly organize an international conference on sustainable technology. He urged the students to take up research projects on the upcoming green technologies and the participants to be a part of this great movement so that society becomes aware of the need of environmental technologies. Mementos were presented to all the distinguished speakers by the Chief Guest. Shri S R Aggarwal, Secretary General, IETE, concluded the proceedings with the vote of thanks.


MoU between IETE and IET



ITEM 4 TO APPOINT AUDITORS FOR THE YEAR 2011-12


