Minute No. BPGS/75/96/207

Admission of candidates with AMIE qualification to M.Tech.

"The Board resolved that on an experimental basis candidates with an AMIE should be asked to satisfactorily complete 24 UG credits prescribed by the Department concerned before being eligible for admission to a P.G. course. The admission to the PG course will be by normal tests and interview processes and the completion of the above 24 UG credits shall confer no right for admission. This recommendation may now be submitted to the Senate for approval."

Copy of relevant extract of Item No.2 of of the Minutes of 38th meeting of the Senate held on 18.10.1975.

It was further decided that for purposes of admission to M.Tech. courses the Institute shall consider equivalent to the AMIE all examinations of professional Institutes which are considered equivalent to it by the UPSC for recruitment to superior services in the Government. The admission rules for all such students will be the same as that for candidates possessing AMIE qualifications.
